

What's Next

Now that you have completed the try out process for Fighting Fish, what's the next step?

SACAC will contact you, via e-mail, by Wednesday 20th August to let you know your tryout status. You will be supplied with one of the 3 following letters

- You have made the team. If so, see below for information on joining.
- A wait list offer. This means you have the potential to join the team but all slots in your age group/squad level are currently full. As spaces become available you will be offered a place in the team. You CAN NOT pay any money or formally join the team until a slot opens for your swimmer.
- You have specific area/strokes that may need improvement. We will give a number of options for obtaining other lessons/coaches/teams. You may also like try out for the team again either in January or next August.

If you receive an e-mail from SACAC telling you that you have made the team:

The e-mail attachment will inform you of which squad level you are being placed onto (Pre, Mini, Junior, Intermediate, Development, HighSchool Pre-Season)

Stop into SACAC and pay your SACAC registration fee (if you have not already paid for the current year) as well as your Fighting Fish fees. All fees must be paid by MONDAY AUGUST 25th and your swimmer must start training that week in order to secure a spot on the team. Swimmers with fees not paid by that date will forfeit their spot to a swimmer on the wait list.

Practice begins on Monday, 25th August. You can pick up a practice schedule in the SACAC office when you stop in to pay fees. Practices are offered on a variety of days and times for all squad levels.

There is supervised study hall in the MS/IS cafeteria for Primary and Intermediate students before the 3pm and 4:20-4:30 practices. Primary students walk with the SACAC aide to the cafeteria where they will be met by our aide, Ms Salmah, until they are walked to practice at 3:00 or 4:20-4:30. IS students need to make their way to the IS/MS cafeteria where they will sign in with Ms Salmah until they are escorted to practice. Please READ your handbook for more information on this.

Uniform fittings will take place the week of 01 Sept. Uniform price is included in the Fighting Fish registration fee.
